We also reward our staff members for pursuing further educational degrees. Many of our teachers have or are pursuing California teaching credentials and master's degrees in teaching. Academic Excellence

Alta Loma Christian School has always sought to provide its students with a quality academic education that is founded on biblical principles. Our teachers use carefully selected curriculum along with the latest educational methods to create an optimal environment for student learning. Most of our students maintain above average grades and score well above the national average on the Stanford Achievement Test. We continue to move forward in improving our performance as a school, however. This year ALCS began the process of accreditation through the Association of Christian Schools International, a journey through which we will seek to further refine our educational program over the next four years.



Enrichment Opportunities

We believe that education should involve more than the core subjects. That's why we provide our students with the chance to explore special avenues of learning through weekly enrichment classes. All of our students in pre-kindergarten through eighth grade receive training in physical education, computer technology, library, Spanish, and music at least once a week. Classes are taught by teachers who are specially trained in their subject area. It is our desire to allow students to excel in every possible way and to provide an opportunity for students who may be gifted in these subjects to grow in their talents. We think that it makes our students even better prepared to sort through the various avenues of learning that will be open to them in high school. In the meantime, it gives them a fabulous educational experience.



Extracurricular Clubs & Classes

At ALCS, the learning doesn't end when school does. We provide plenty of opportunities for our students to grow outside of the classroom. Our extracurricular groups include sports training, cheer and dance classes, book clubs, private tutoring, etiquette classes, yearbook club, children's choir, and AWANA. Families can register students for various classes throughout the year, allowing parents to choose programs that will benefit their children the most.





Spiritual Growth & Service

Although we are completely dedicated to providing our students with an excellent education, our mission as a school has always been to assist our students in growing stronger in the Christian faith. We are committed to the truth found in God's word, and this commitment guides everything that we do at ALCS. Along with daily devotions and Bible curriculum taught faithfully in the classroom, our students enjoy worship and teaching in chapel every Wednesday in the campus sanctuary. We also provide service opportunities for our children like Operation Christmas Child and ministry outreach field trips to the community. Family members are invited to participate in a weekly parent prayer team which meets on campus, and our Family Ministry Coordinator is available at all times for both prayer and visitation to any of our families who are in need. It's all part of our desire to care for our family here at ALCS while continuing to share God's love with the community around us.



Technology & Media Connections

In today's world, it is crucial that we help our students and families keep up with the pace of technology. That's why we've taken steps to integrate technology into so many different aspects of the educational experience at ALCS. Academic scores, attendance, and other student information is recorded through RenWeb, a comprehensive school management system that provides constant connection between the classroom, office, and home. Through our school website at www.alchristian.com, visitors can download admissions materials, email staff members, and view school documents. Students attend a weekly computer class in our school technology lab, and each classroom is equipped with at least one computer for teacher and student use. ALCS also participates in the Accelerated Reader program. This excellent reading program allows students to read books that are appropriate to their reading level, take quizzes on computer, and track their own performance in reading comprehension. A wide selection of books are available to our students in our school library which contains over 6,000 titles. Parents can also connect to Accelerated Reader online to monitor their child's progress. We continue to seek new ways to prepare our students for an increasingly technological world.





Daycare & Summer Camp

We understand the needs of working families at ALCS, so we are pleased to provide a daycare program for our students. Before school care begins at 6:30 every morning, and after school care ends at 6:00 in the evening. At the end of the school day, daycare students have the opportunity to complete homework, enjoy a snack, and relax with friends. From June until August we also hold a fantastic summer day camp for students. Children have the opportunity to participate in exciting activities both on and off campus while in the care of our staff. Specific information about registration and payment plans is available to parents through the school office.



Parent Involvement

There are a multitude of ways for parents to get involved on campus. Our Parent Teacher Fellowship has monthly meetings as well as annual events for our families including festivals, walkathons, and restaurant nights. Room parent coordinators assist our teachers with classroom parties and activities.
